HIV prevention efforts often overlook older women because it is incorrectly assumed that they no longer engage in sexual relations. Unfortunately, many still-active women have not yet heard the message that their behavior can put them at risk of becoming infected with a sexually transmitted disease (STD).

Older women who learn this sad fact by testing HIV positive face a double hardship: the stigma of living with a disease considered disgraceful, and the burden of aging in a society that neither values nor respects its seniors.

Prevention of HIV in older women and support for those already infected are the dual aims of a new program under the direction of Jane P. Fowler.
